

## Derma 2.0 Peels

*Derma 2.0's PMU Remover alongside the Pyruvic, Glycolic, Mandelic, Whitening and Purifying Peel options allow you to target all skincare conditions and PMU removal with the best peels on the market.*

**Mandelic Acid:** Gentle on sensitive skin, tackles pigmentation & acne.

**Glycolic Acid:** Smooths texture, reduces fine lines & sun damage.

**Pyruvic Acid:** Fights oiliness & stubborn acne.

**Salicylic Acid:** Clears pores, stops breakouts in their tracks.

**Azelaic Acid:** Calms rosacea & fades dark spots.

**Lactic Acid:** Hydrates dry skin & evens out tone.

**The standard protocol for optimal results from all Derma 2.0 peels is 5 sessions, once per week (except Derma-Peel TCA Strong!) Before using any Derma 2.0 peels, ensure the skin is perfectly cleansed. Depending on skin condition, cleanse first with the Derma 2.0 Hydrating mousse (normal/dry skin) or the Derma 2.0 Purifying Mousse (oily skin)**

**IMPORTANT: ALWAYS PATCH TEST BEHIND THE EAR PRIOR TO TREATMENT.**

After initial cleansing, ensure skin is degreased with the Pre-Treatment Degreasing Solution, avoiding the eye area and mucous membranes. Always let it sit for 30 seconds. This is a preparatory solution essential to acidify the skin pH before a chemical exfoliation treatment (pre-peeling and pre-needling) ensuring optimal penetration and action of the chosen chemical peeling or the preparation of the skin for any aesthetic treatment (peeling, needling, dermabrasion etc.) Applied with well soaked gauze, the degreasing solution eliminates the hydro-lipidic layer by balancing and acidifying the skin's pH.

The laying time, number of applications and the layers to obtain results of all Derma 2.0 chemical peels are indicative and may vary depending on the severity of the imperfections being treated.



**Derma 2.0 Bio Peel:** This is an advanced biorevitalising peeling treatment. Combining bi-phasic chemical peeling with Biorevitalising properties that act on all signs of premature and consolidated skin aging. Stimulates Collagen production **encouraging a smooth skin texture, rehydration and toning of the skin.** Powerful mix based on DMAE, Vitamin E, Lactic acid, Mandelic acid, Salicylic acid, Serine, Glycine, Proline, Rice Oil, Rose Muscat Oil, Pollen Extract, Soy Extract, Olive Oil, Argan Oil. Suitable for all skin types. **Leave on for between 10-15 minutes.**

**Derma 2.0 Glycolic Acid 50% Peel:** Glycolic acid scar removing treatment 50% peel – Glycolic acid is an alpha-hydroxy acid and is one of the substances most used in aesthetics and aesthetic medicine to perform superficial-medium exfoliation. Renewing chemical peel based on non-buffered glycolic acid peeling 50% at pH stabilised 2.0. **Valid for improving the appearance of superficial-medium wrinkles, as a scar removing treatment and stretch marks (including white ones.) Leave on for 5-20 minutes.**

**Derma 2.0 Mandelic Acid 50% Peel:** Chemical peeling with firming and non-photosensitising action. **Adjuvant in the treatment of ptosis, very superficial wrinkles, and uneven texture.** Suitable for all types of skin and in all seasons of the year. **Leave on for between 20-40 minutes.**

**Derma 2.0 Purifying Peel:** Chemical peeling active against active phase acne, comedones, blackheads and impure skin. Based on a powerful blend of Pyruvic Acid, Salicylic Acid, Azelaic Acid and Lactic Acid with dermoplastic, keratolytic, sebostatic, antimicrobial and preventive against post-traumatic / inflammatory hyperpigmentation. Not suitable for sensitive skin. **Leave on for between 5-15 minutes.**

**Derma 2.0 Whitening Peel:** Depigmenting and anti-dark spot peel. **Chemical Peeling active on hyperpigmentation such as senile lentigo, solar lentigo, melasma and chloasma.** Based on Glycolic Acid, Resorcinol, Kojic Acid, Azelaic Acid, Arbutin and Lactobionic Acid. It works effectively by breaking down the accumulations of melanin and inhibiting its over-production. Not suitable for sensitive skin. **Leave on for between 8-16 minutes.**

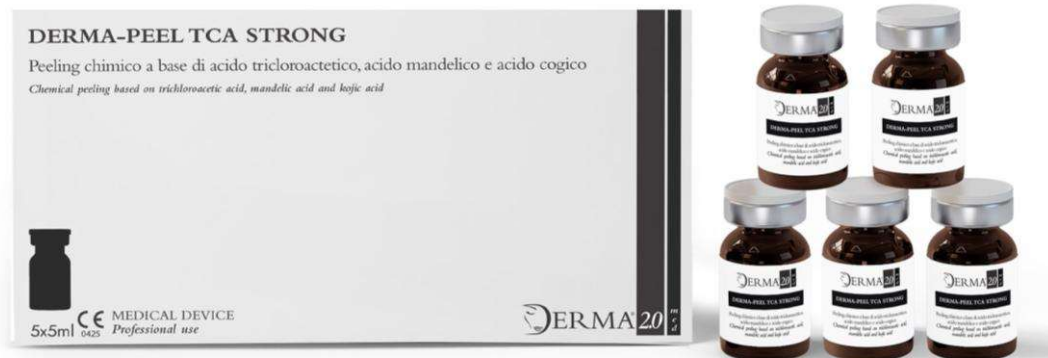
**Derma 2.0 Hydrating Peel:** Professional-grade chemical peel designed to deeply rehydrate, stimulate cell turnover, and illuminate the skin. Based on a powerful blend of lactic acid, lactobionic acid and other active ingredients, it is suitable for all skin types, especially dry and mature skin. **Leave on for between 2-10 minutes.**

***Important: After any Derma 2.0 peel treatment, apply two layers of Derma 2.0 Post Peeling Neutralising solution. Follow with a layer of Derma 2.0 Regen Post Treatment Mask. Finish with Derma 2.0 SPF 50 for full protection.***

## **Derma 2.0 PMU Remover**

Derma 2.0 PMU Derma-Remover is an effective peel based microneedling product for lightening semi- permanent make-up in the eyebrow area. A mixture of expertly selected acids to allow the resurfacing and consequent expulsion of the molecules that make up the pigments, finally allowing even the lightest pigments to be eliminated. Glycolic Acid and Lactic Acid (two of the most tolerated and well-known organic acids) act progressively and gradually to lighten semi-permanent tattoos. ## Derma 2.0 Derma-Peel TCA Strong



Derma-Peel TCA Strong is a CE certified medical-grade facial peel designed for professional use only. Formulated with Trichloroacetic Acid (TCA), Kojic Acid, and Mandelic Acid, this powerful treatment effectively targets acne, rosacea, hyperpigmentation, medium to deep wrinkles, blemishes, acne scars, and stretch marks. It enhances skin brightness, evens out tone, boosts elasticity, and reduces discoloration for a more youthful, radiant complexion.

### Treatment Procedure

**Makeup Removal:** Remove all makeup using a non-oily micellar water.

**Cleansing:** Thoroughly cleanse the face with a specific cleansing mousse based on skin type:

**Derma-Purifying Mousse** → For oily, acne-prone skin.

**Derma-Hydrating Mousse** → For dry and sensitive skin.

**Degreasing:** Apply the degreasing solution to the skin and allow it to evaporate for approximately 30 seconds.

### Pre-Treatment Peeling (Choose based on skin concern)

**50% Glycolic Acid Peel** → For severely aged & photo-aged skin.

**Derma-Whitening Peel** → For hyperpigmentation issues.

**Derma-Purifying Peel** → For acne and rosacea-prone skin.

**Exposure Time:** Varies based on Fitzpatrick skin type, but generally 3-5 minutes.

**Preparation of TCA Peel:** Pour the entire contents of one vial into a container.

**Application of TCA Peel:** After the pre-treatment peel exposure time, apply Derma-Peel TCA Strong as evenly as possible using a fan brush (Do NOT use gauze, as the brush ensures uniform application).

**Application Order:** Start with the forehead, then move to the temples, nose, cheeks, peribuccal area, and chin.

**Patient Sensations During Treatment:** The patient will likely experience burning, tingling, and heat sensations (either widespread or localised.) To minimise discomfort, use a fan or air-blowing device to cool the skin.

**End-Point of Treatment:** Frosting. Wait for the appearance of Level II Frosting (second-degree frosting.)

***If frosting occurs immediately on the entire treated area, proceed to the next step. If frosting appears only in some areas, reapply the peel (layering it over the previous application) in areas where frosting has not yet developed.***

**Neutralisation & Post-Treatment Care:** Once frosting has appeared on all treated areas, neutralise the peel using the Derma-Neutralising Solution. Rinse the area thoroughly and apply the Derma-Regen Mask. Leave the mask on until fully absorbed, while continuing to blow air on the face for comfort. Once absorbed, apply a generous layer of Derma-Sun SPF 50+ sunscreen.

**Post-Treatment Guidelines for Patients:**

(Avoid for 24-48 hours)

*Hot baths*

*Aggressive cleansing*

*Makeup*

*Exfoliating agents (Vitamin C, Vitamin A, Salicylic Acid, Glycolic Acid, or other harsh ingredients)*

For 7-14 days, apply only occlusive and hydrating creams/ointments (such as hyaluronic acid or pure Vaseline).

Peeling Process: Skin will begin peeling within 48 hours. Peeling typically lasts 10 days.

**NOTE: PATIENTS MUST NOT FORCEFULLY REMOVE FLAKING SKIN.**

**Treatment Frequency:** A single session can deliver significant improvement. If needed, the treatment can be repeated after 1 month, but no more than 2 sessions per year.
